
NSTRUCTIONS

- To ensure the bulkhead weatherstrip sticks, make sure the surface temperature of your truck is at least 50°F and will remain so for at least a day.
 - 50°F min.
- Clean the top of the bulkhead thoroughly with a clean, lint-free cloth and rubbing alcohol or glass cleaner. Allow to dry.
- It is very important that the top of the bulkhead be both dry and absolutely free of dirt, oil, or any other contaminants prior to application of the weatherstrip.





- Start affixing the weatherstrip to the top of the bulkhead so
 - a. tight against the interior edge of the driver-side bed rail cap,
 - b. as far toward the cab as possible while maintaining contact with the bulkhead along its entire length, and
 - c. in a straight line.
- Press down firmly with your thumb on the weatherstrip along its entire length.
- Never stretch the weatherstrip when applying. If you do, its adhesive will fail.
- Cut the weatherstrip so that its end is tight against the driver side of the nose of the cover.
- Repeat steps 2–3 on the passenger side.



- After you have installed your DiamondBack cover, leave its cab panel closed and locked for 24 hours to allow the bulkhead weatherstrip adhesive, which is pressure-activated, to fully cure.
- 24 hours Adhesive Cure Time



Factory bed rail caps can themselves leak. If absolute protection from moisture is essential for you, apply a bead of silicone to the cabward end of each bed rail cap where it meets the sheet metal after you install the bulkhead weatherstrip.
