



To ensure the sealing mount tape adheres properly, make sure the temperature of the cleaned surface is at least 50°F and will remain so for at least a day.












The bulkhead weatherstrip will stick to a spray-in bed liner just fine.



- Affix the **weatherstrip** to the top of the bulkhead so it's: a, tight against the interior edges of the bed rail caps at
 - both ends. and
 - b. aligned with the perimeter weatherstrip of the cab panel if you have a DiamondBack HD, SE, or SwitchBack, or
 - c. in a straight line as far toward the cab as possible while maintaining contact with the bulkhead along its entire length if you have a DiamondBack 270 or 180.
 - Press down firmly with your thumb on the weatherstrip along its entire length.
 - Never stretch the weatherstrip when applying. If you do, its adhesive will fail.





After you have installed your cover, leave its front panel(s) closed and locked for 24 hours to allow the bulkhead weatherstrip adhesive, which is pressure-activated, to fully cure.
